Section .6 Solar Emissions and Related Terrestrial Phenomena

Section 6 was newly established in June, 1968 for the study of Solar-Terrestrial Relationship, especially the relations between solar emissions and related terrestrial phenomena. We have a plan in I. A. S. Y. to make observations of the interplanetary scintillation of radio sources, which was found by Hewish, et. al. (Nature, 203, 1214 (1964), 209, 1188 (1966), 213, 343 (1967)), for studying the disturbed solar wind. The present necessity for this section is to have it sufficiently staffed.
