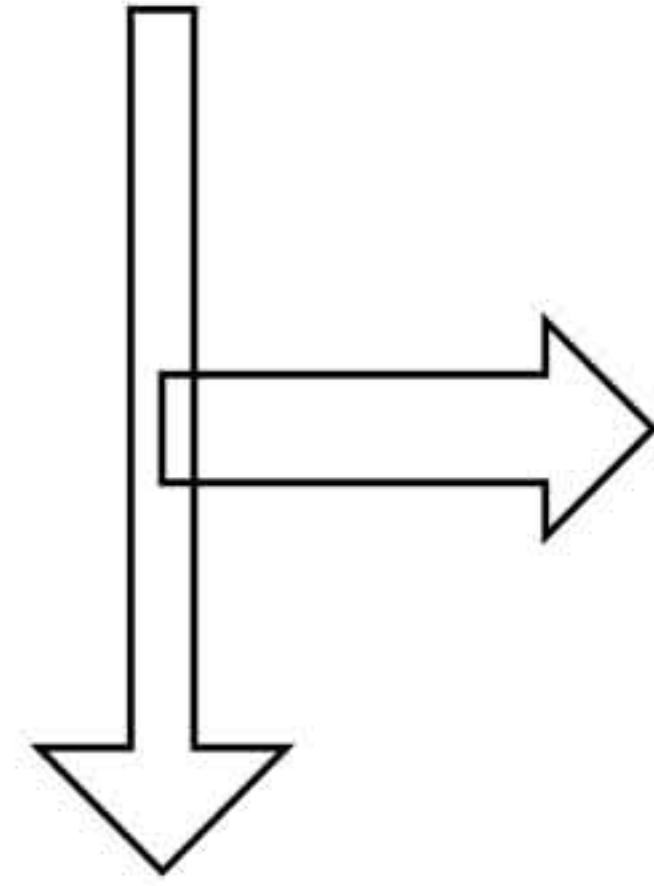
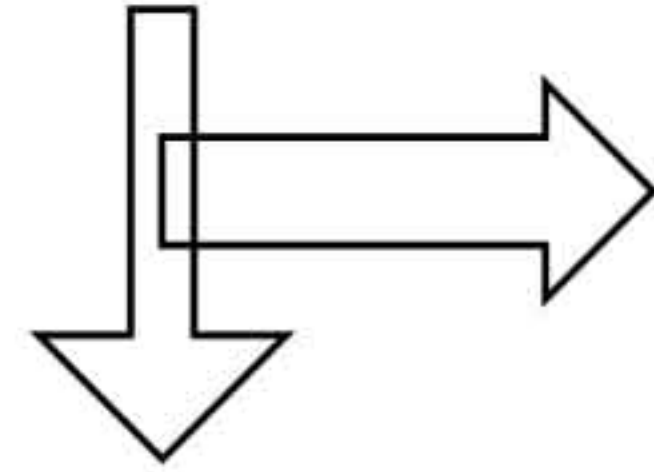


Tibial plateau fractures : 430 cases



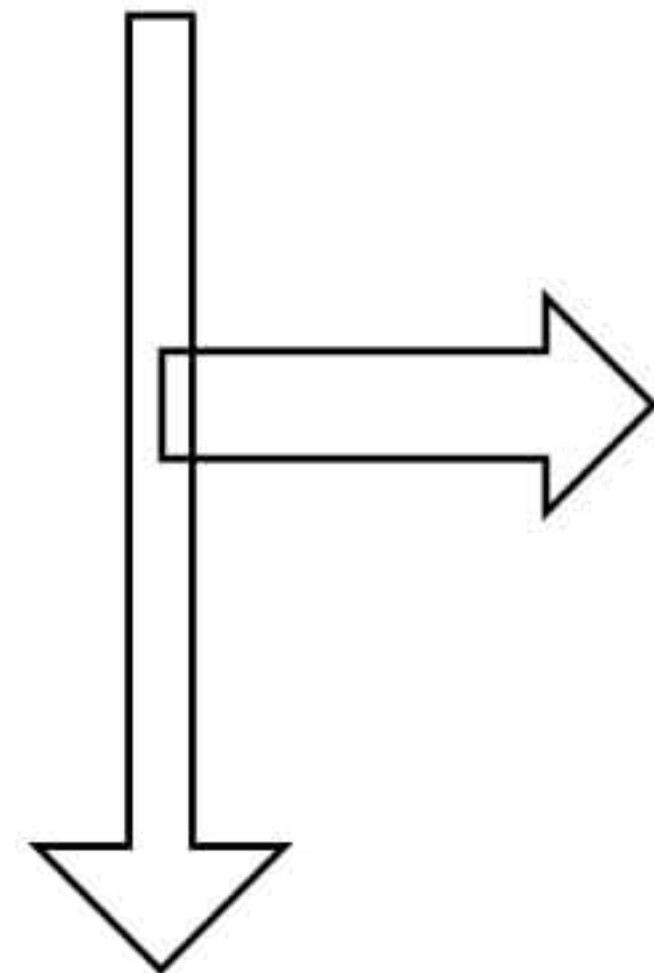
- patients with no available preoperative radiograph or CT:11 cases
- patients <18 years of age:3 cases
- patients with a history of knee pain or knee dysfunction (meniscus, ACL or PCL injury):5 cases
- patients classified as Schatzker type I ,IV, V and VI:238 cases

Schatzker type II and III : 173 cases



- patients with multiple fracture:3 cases
- patients who did not undergo arthroscopy:87

Patients who underwent arthroscopy:83 cases



- patients with a history of postoperative infection:2 cases
- patients who could not perform weight bearing even after undergoing surgery due to a traumatic spine or brain injury:1 cases
- patients who underwent amputation due to a severe crushing injury:1 cases
- patients who had flap tear or discoid tear:2 cases
