## Section 6 Solar Emissions and Related Terrestrial Phenomena

Two observatories at Toyokawa and Fujigane have been completed and observations of interplanetary scintillation of radio-sources for studying the solar wind have been carried out since June, 1970.

The results of preliminary observations are described in detail in this volume. We are now enlarging the aerial at Toyokawa in an east-west direction to double its effective area.
